Quarantine Plan 2021-22

EXPOSURE

Exposure is defined as being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes of cumulative time (within 24-hours) with a person who has a confirmed case of COVID-19.

WHEN TO QUARANTINE

When we believe there has been exposure for our staff or students, we will initiate a quarantine protocol for all who have been exposed to the positive COVID-19 case. If it is determined that exposure has not occurred, we will not initiate quarantine.

CLASSROOM QUARANTINE PROTOCOL

If a classroom must be quarantined due to COVID-19 exposure, the following steps will be taken:

1. Parents will be informed and 10-calendar day countdown will begin.
2. Students who can prove COVID-19 positive in the past 3 months may return to school immediately and miss NO school.
3. Students who can prove negative test (taken on or after day 5), are non-symptomatic and have no other COVID exposure may return on Day 8.
4. All other students who do not fit the above requirements may return to class on Day 11.

No student or staff member is required to supply personal information and may choose to take the full quarantine. However, if any families wish to shorten the quarantine for their child, documentation must accompany the child to school, where it will be forwarded to the school office.

DISTANCE LEARNING AND QUARANTINE

When a classroom is sent into quarantine, the following learning plan will be followed but may be adjusted and customized for each specific situation:

DAY 1 Student work is gathered, and parents come for pick-up of materials

DAY 2	Online learning begins
DAYS 3-6	Online learning continues
DAY 7	Last day of online learning
DAYS 8-10	Students who can prove negative test (taken on or after day 5), are non-symptomatic and have no other COVID exposure may return to class; class work sent home (no online learning) for remaining students
DAY 11	All students may return to class

As long as students participate in classroom activities, students will be counted as present for the learning day.
